THE CORONATION SHIELD GROUP OF COMPETITIONS

CORONATION SHIELD Teams of four, 20 shots each at 25 yards. Entry fee £10 per team.

<u>CORONATION CUP</u> Individual event concurrent with Coronation Shield, but separate entries also accepted. Entry fee £2.50 per person.

GOBLIN CUP Individual event, 20 shots at 50m and 20 shots at 100y. Entry fee £2.50 per person.

<u>SILVER JUBILEE TROPHY</u> Individual event, aggregate of Coronation Cup and Goblin Cup. Entry fee £2.50 per person.

<u>LEATHERHEAD AUXILIARY FORCES SHIELD</u> Individual event for Light Weight Sporting Rifle shot standing unsupported at 20 yards, PL14, any sights. Each competitor will be allowed 5 minutes per detail for unlimited sighters before shooting cards 1 and 2. Each detail will comprise 20 competition shots, 10 on each of 2 targets, to be shot within 15 minutes for each pair of targets. Entry fee £2.50

RULES

1. Competition held towards the end of October.

2. N.S.R.A. Choose your own start rules will apply unless other wise stated below.

3. Each ten shot target is treated separately and must have 10 scoring shots. Targets with 11 or more shots will have the lowest ten shots scored with 1 penalty for each excess shot.

A pair of targets with 9 shots on one and 11 shots on the other will have the first scored with a miss (10 points off) and the second will have the lowest 10 shots scored with a 1 point penalty for each excess shot*.

Cross shots onto another competitors target will be scored with the addition of a 2 point penalty* providing the cross shot can be identified.

*Penalties are deducted after the start has been applied to the gun score.

4. The minimum start will be 5 per ten shot card and for the Goblin Cup only, the maximum start will be 15.

5. Ties will be broken as follows;

Coronation Shield – The team with the highest number of "100"s. If still a tie then the team with the highest number of "100"s on the second card*. If still a tie then by shooting off on single cards until a result is reached.

Coronation Cup & LAF Shield – by shooting off on single cards until a result is reached for first place and for runner up.

Goblin Cup – by the highest score at 100 yards. If still a tie, then by counting back from the last 100 yard card*. If still a tie then by shooting off on single 100 yard cards until a result is reached. (If time is short it may be necessary to use the Silver Jubilee score to break the tie)

Silver Jubilee Trophy – as for the Goblin Cup.

* Cards will be number 1 & 2 at each distance for the purpose of breaking ties and must be shot in this order.

6. Challenges will be accepted on payment of £1, which will be refunded if the challenge is successful. The decision of the Stats officer is final.

7. Reserves may shoot in all competitions and a new start may be used but all such changes must be advised to the Stats officer prior to shooting.

8. Conduct of shooting – all shooting will be squadded and teams will shoot in the same detail. Detail times will be notified in advance. Twenty minutes will be allowed for twenty match shots plus unlimited sighters. Coaching is not allowed.
